Memorial Awards Almost \$34,000 in Grants Next Sunday. Next Sunday the Ministry Endowment Board will award grants to ministries within Memorial, in our community, and around the world. During the fellowship hour the grant recipients will share information and thanks for the grant monies received.

Help Haiti Mission Team. The Haiti Mission Team will receive a grant next weekend to help build a house in Haiti. The build will start before their arrival and they hope to be there to work on some of the finish work at completion. The grant award covers two-thirds of the cost of the home. Memorial has the opportunity to be involved with the project by making a donation to cover the remaining \$1500. After worship on November 10 and 11, you are invited to make a donation toward the home. More details will be shared that weekend from the Haiti Mission Team.

It Is Bean Time Again. Memorial will once again partner with Nevada churches and service organizations to gather food items to provide a free Thanksgiving meal for Nevada families. Your generosity continues to be an inspiration to the Nevada Parks and Recreation staff who coordinate the effort. Extra beans are divided between the Nevada Community Cupboard and Cubbie's Cupboard to provide food the rest of the year.

Council Discusses Decision-Making with Members. At its September meeting, the Church Council held an open discussion about the model of decision-making used by the congregation. Sixteen members of the congregation participated. Seven of those who spoke asked for a return to exclusively parliamentary decision-making; five were supportive of the current provision of consensus decision-making. The current bylaw in Memorial's constitution provides for the council to use discretion in choosing either consensus decision-making and parliamentary decision-making. Four members who attended the conversation did not speak. The council intends to return to this matter early in 2019.
