*Confession and Forgiveness


In the name of God, who makes a way in the wilderness, walks with us, and guides us in our pilgrimage. **Amen.**

The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, the love of God, and the communion of the Holy Spirit be with you all. **And also with you.**






The Gospel according to John **Glory to You, O Lord**




